

Covering our "bases"

1st base

2nd base

Understanding and appreciating diverse perspectives; navigating differences with grace and wisdom.

3rd base

Racial Healing

Bridging divides and fostering unity by celebrating our differences and aligning with God's Word.

Empathetic listening is the starting point of intercultural relationships. - You: A diverse group of church stakeholders representing varying ages, races, genders, and physical abilities




