MINISTRY DESCRIPTION

The Worship Director will serve as the main Worship Leader in addition to a "second face of the church" for the congregation, under the direction of the Site Director. Cornerstone's Cokato site is one year newly launched and a still mobile, second campus to our Litchfield site. As a startup site, the Worship Director will serve along-side Site Director in providing leadership, scheduling, and general oversite to other ministry areas closely associated with the Sunday morning experience. Such ministry areas could include, but not be limited to: Tech Teams, Guest Services, and Setup/Tear Down Teams.

The Worship Director, in collaboration with the Site and Technical Directors, will serve towards meeting the needs of a diverse community by leading, planning, organizing and teaching the worship ministry of Cornerstone.

The Worship Director will serve under the Programming Team to create worship experiences that inspire, enable, educate, encourage, and challenge both believers and those who are seeking, to explore and deepen their understanding of a relationship with Jesus.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Mission, Vision, Values and Strategy

- Serve as a "second face of the Church" to champion the mission, vision, values and strategy of Cornerstone Church and the worship ministry.
- Serve as a catalyst in continuing the ongoing vision and direction of worship.
- Develop and implement strategies for spiritual transformation and growth within the worship ministry.
- Recruit, train and equip leaders and team members within the worship ministry on local site along with collaboration from other site leaders.
- Together with appropriate staff members (i.e. worship, technical, media, communications, etc.), creatively construct reach others for Christ, no matter where they are on their walk.
- Develop talented site volunteer teams in multiple areas (i.e. musicians, AV/tech, media, communications).
- Responsible for development and oversight of the local site worship ministry budget.

Worship and Services

- Weekly programming expectations include personally, lead worship, on stage 80% of the time (I.e. 4 out of 5 Sundays). Recruit, train other worship leaders for the other 20%
- Provide vision, leadership, and training to the worship ministries, which can include the worship band, technical, media, communications, and creative arts ministries.
- Coordinate and plan worship services, including but not limited to scheduling volunteers, preparing music, organizing rehearsals and incorporating both visual & creative arts into services.
- Work with a programming team in selecting appropriate music, media and other creative elements.
- Coordinate and lead rehearsals for the band, vocals, visual arts and technical support for services.
- Coordinate media and branding campaigns for effective outreach.
- Consistent contact & appreciation meetings/events for volunteers and teams.

Pastoral and Office Staff

- Have a cooperative, healthy and motivating relationship with pastoral and office staff, volunteers and ministry leaders. Leader and encourager of people, able to inspire loyalty and gain the respect of one's peers.
- Attend and contribute positive creative energy to staff meetings and relevant ministry functions. Those
 functions to include services & media needs not related to Sunday morning worship (i.e. outreach events,
 baptism, prayer concerts, special celebrations, branding/advertising initiatives, etc.).
- Contribute to a healthy and fun team environment as you work closely with multiple staff members.
