POSITION SUMMARY

Purpose Statement: We exist to help people improve their relationship with God and each other through our mission to equipping people to know Jesus and follow Him.

Working Relationship

The Director of Worship Arts will report to the Lead Pastor. It is clearly understood that the effectiveness of the Director of Worship Arts will be largely determined by the quality of the relationship and partnership with the Lead Pastor and the Worship team. Maintaining the highest levels of communication, trust, integrity, and loyalty is essential to these relationships.

Summary of Responsibilities

- Oversee the weekend worship experience:
- Lead worship during weekend services
- Meet weekly with the Lead Pastor to prayerfully plan, develop, execute, and evaluate the weekend worship experience
- Strive to implement creativity and variety in the weekend worship experience, including music, visual elements, testimonies of life change, etc.
- Managing the weekend schedule and volunteers using tools and technology
- Communicate the vision and overall goals of Chapel with the Worship Ministry Team and through the weekend worship services
- Maintain leadership and oversight of all aspects worship, including instrumentation, song selection, stage, storage and technology

- Recruit, develop, and shepherd volunteers
- Oversee the Worship Ministry Team, which includes, but is not limited to: worship leaders, vocalists and band members
- Oversee and develop worship leaders as they plan, rehearse, and execute the worship experience
- Recruit, audition, and develop vocalists and instrumental band members
- Ensure the scheduling of the Worship Ministry Team is complete
- Regularly shepherd and care for volunteers

Qualifications:

- A two- or four-year degree from an accredited college/university or equivalent experience is desired
- 2+ years of experience designing worship experiences and leading worship (part or full time)
- A proficiency in singing melody and harmony
- A proficiency in at least one harmonic instrument (ie guitar or piano)

This is a part-time position. Pay is negotiable based on experience and education.
