During that trip, we visited twelve (12) churches and a few ministry partners in eight (8) different states. We added 4,621 miles on our car. Along the way, we had to replace our water pump and the oil pan gasket. The Lord took excellent care of us as we reconnected with our precious global partners that have been sustaining our ministry with finances, prayers and much love. It was a joy to add new ones also. This year has been an awesome year in many ways after four years of staying on the field. Our sharing time was rich and very profound at all the churches, as we had the opportunity to explain details concerning the four couples we have been training. We feel much closer to you after sharing specific requests for our outreach to French-speakers in the Bafoussam area where we are living. We feel more like family as a result of the way you welcomed us into your homes and gave us a Royal Welcome! We look forward to going back to Cameroon with new vigor and a clearer vision.
